Join us for our upcoming Leaders at Lunch program on Tuesday, November 18th from 11:30 AM - 1:30 PM at LeTort View Community Center, where we will be honoring the YWCA Carlisle & Cumberland County and the Cumberland County District Attorney's Office for their collaborative efforts against human trafficking and support of its survivors.

In the last three years, the YWCA of Carlisle & Cumberland County has documented about 140 human trafficking cases and are working to build solutions and opportunities for individuals to move out of Human Trafficking and rebuild their lives. The Cumberland County District Attorney's office created the Human Trafficking Task Force in 2022. Since then, the task force has arrested more than 100 people through human trafficking prosecutions and shut down seven illegal Asian massage parlor operations.

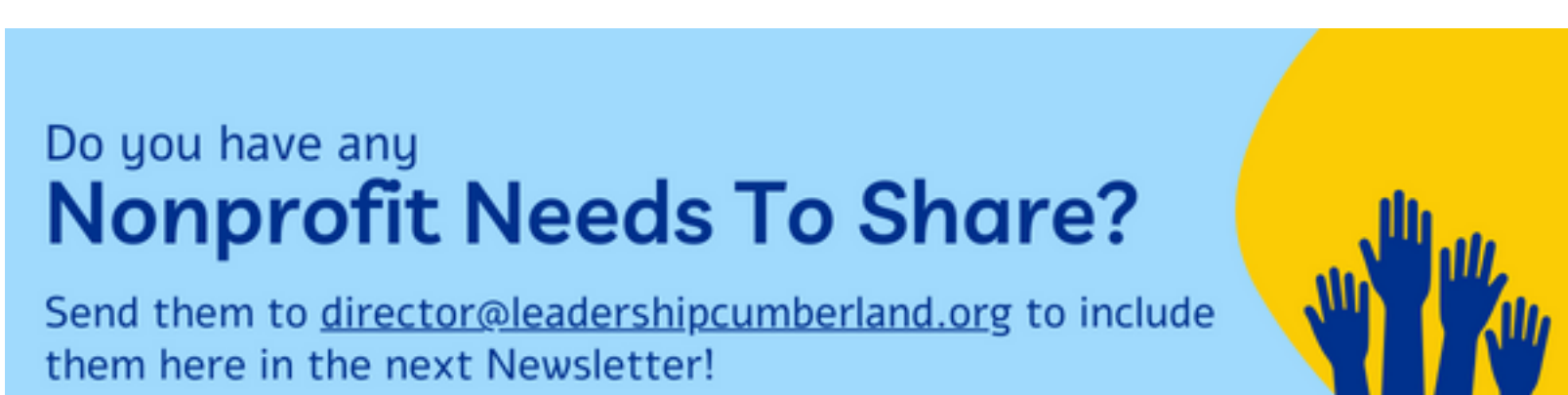

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED FOR CASA PROGRAM

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Volunteers are the backbone of our program and the success for our children. The mission of the Cumberland County Court Appointed Special Advocate (CASA) Program is to assist the Court in determining what serves in the best interest of abused and/or neglected children whose cases are in the Dependency Court system. Through independent information-gathering, active case engagement, trained CASA volunteers develop and present their recommendations to the Court to aid in establishing a safe, permanent and nurturing home for the child or sibling group to whom they have been appointed. The four key roles of a CASA volunteer are: gather relevant information, facilitate, advocate for the child's best interests, and monitor the case- all with the goal of helping to support that child or sibling group to reach PERMANENCY. 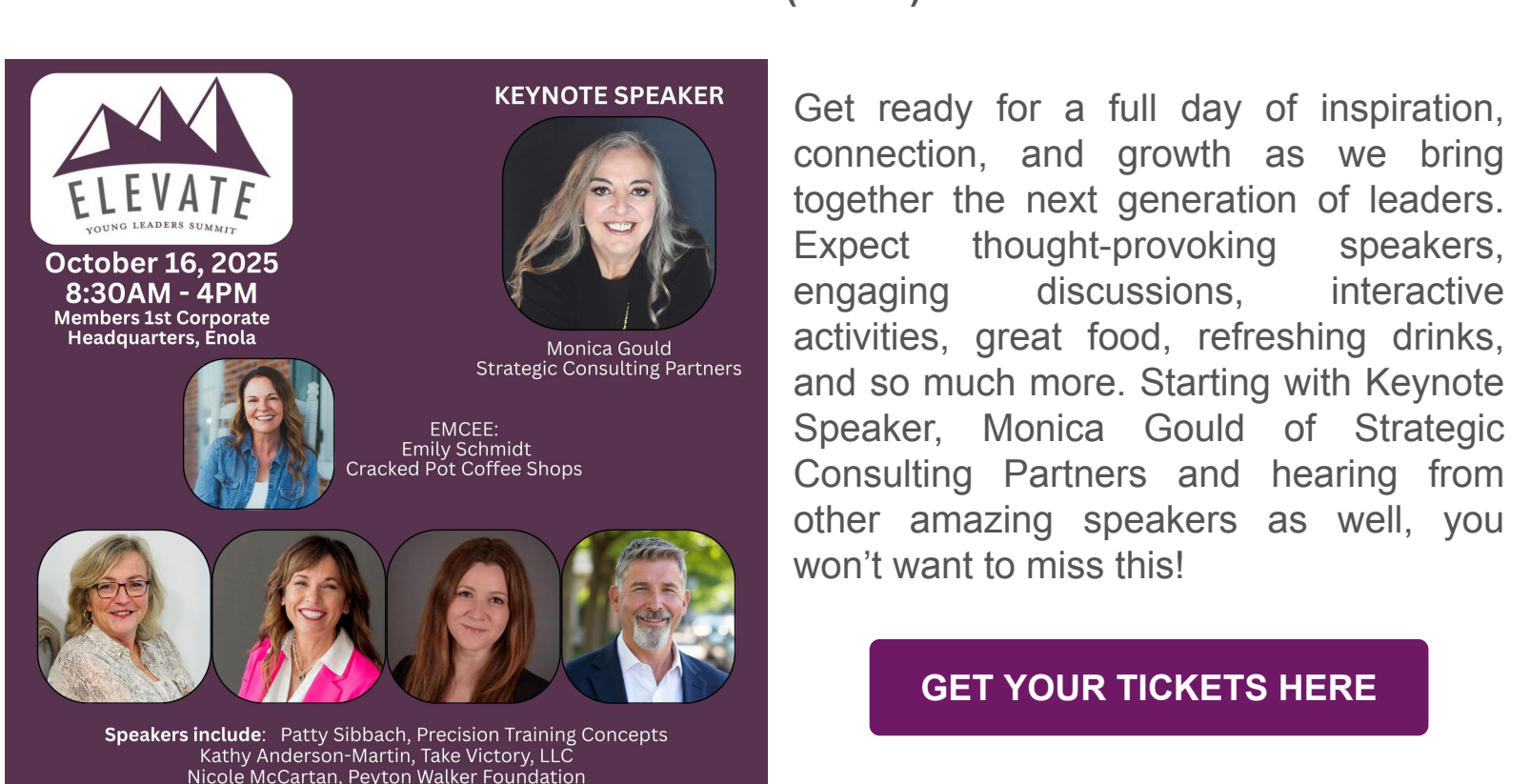
JOIN EMPLOYMENT SKILLS CENTER'S BOARD OF DIRECTORS
