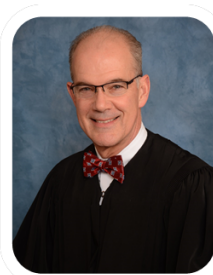
Honoring the Cumberland County Treatment and Opioid Intervention Courts

The evening concluded with a special announcement. At the start of the new fiscal year in July, Leadership Cumberland will acquire Junior Leadership (for area high school juniors), a program focused on leadership competencies and community service. We are very excited to offer this program!

Thank you to everyone who came out to celebrate with us!

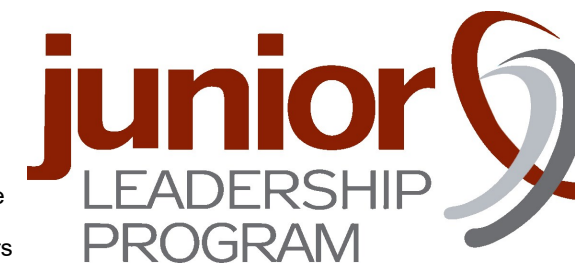


Junior Leadership Program

As we stated above, we recently acquired the Junior Leadership Program (JLP)! If you aren't familiar with this program, it is very similar to what we do here at Leadership Cumberland—only for high school juniors.


The goal of this program is to familiarize young leaders with the various elements that form a strong and dynamic community as well as help students develop leadership skills. JLP will consist of an orientation, a series of 6 weekday sessions, a weekend community event, and a graduation ceremony. The program will be offered to Central Pennsylvania's private, public and parochial school students.


The curriculum will acquaint participants with community needs, opportunities, challenges and resources. It will give them the opportunity to develop leadership, communication and team building skills. It will also provide them with the opportunity to interact with students from other schools, community leaders and decision makers.

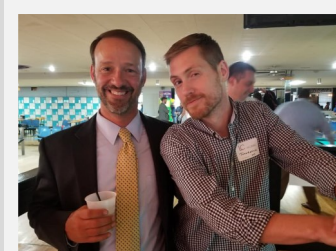

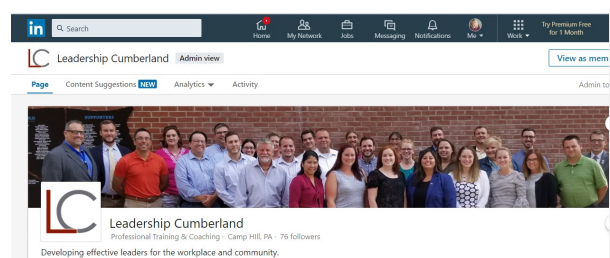
