LC FELLOWS SHARE COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT PROJECT RESULTS

At our Graduation Celebration we were able to share the results of the Fellows' Community Engagement Projects that were completed throughout the year, and we're so excited to share those results with all of you as well! The following nonprofits were helped throughout the 2021-2022 class year:

Fellows helped create a plan for **New Hope Ministries** to launch the **Teen Job Readiness Program** in Eastern Cumberland County for school districts and employers for New Hope Ministries, a Christian Social Service Agency, servicing York, Adams, and Cumberland Counties.

Fellows were asked to help **YWCA Carlisle** re-energize their *Race Against Racism* event that hadn't been held since 2019. Their efforts included improving event awareness, finding a new location, and helping to increase the overall funds raised.

Fellows planned, created, and executed a spring event for girls in grades K-5 including hands-on activities, led by community businesses and partners that center around the **Girl Scout in the Heart of PA's** 4 pillars. The **STEM Fair** event helped build awareness about opportunities available through GirlScouts and recruit new girls and their families.

Fellows were asked to create a *Volunteer Management System* for Community Aid's Neighbors Helping Neighbors program. This program supports local nonprofits through funding, education, and access to exclusive benefits Community Aid can offer in theHanover, Mechanicsburg, and York areas.

Fellows provided guidance on multiple initiatives for the **Joseph Simpson Library** in downtown Mechanicsburg including creating a a brand identity, expanding **DEI programming** and content, and connecting with the diverse community population in the areas the library serves.

Fellows helped the **US Army Carlisle Barracks**, one of our nation's oldest military installations, establish a purpose and funding for long-term preservation of the *War College Farmhouse* (a historical structure with Indian School ties) while allowing room to promote Tribal healing.

Overall these projects saved the six nonprofits over \$28,000!

NEW LIFESAVING PROGRAM COMES TO CUMBERLAND COUNTY Did you know that every year in Cumberland County over 150 of our friends, children and neighbors are affected by Sudden Cardiac Arrest? Every minute that a person is in

and neighbors are affected by Sudden Cardiac Arrest? Every minute that a person is in cardiac arrest their survival rate drops 7-10%. Immediate bystander intervention with an AED is required to meaningfully save lives. To change these startling statistics Cumberland County is proud to support a new initiative called the 4 Minute City. The Peyton Walker Foundation located in Camp Hill and the Emergency Health Services Federation are partnering with Avive Solutions new cutting-edge technology to place intelligent AEDs throughout the community with the goal of offering cardiac arrest victims access to lifesaving help within 4 minutes of 911 calls. This project will revolutionize Sudden Cardiac Arrest (SCA) care in Cumberland County. Most importantly, this program is working with the citizens of Cumberland County to create a culture of saving lives from cardiac arrest through free training and educational resources so everyone is prepared to save a life. And last, we are working on distributing approximately 300 Avive AEDs in Cumberland County. We are looking to our Cumberland County citizens to become AED hosts. Hosts will be trained on how to perform high quality hands-only CPR and how to use an AED. You can help save the life of someone in Cumberland County.
