

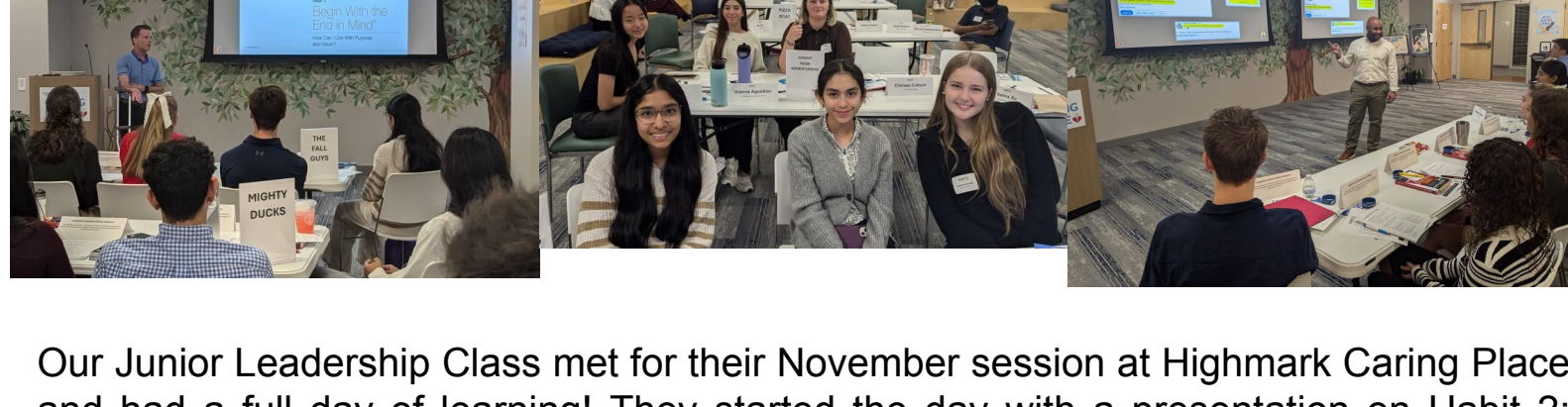
OUR FELLOWS LEARNED TO INCORPORATE DIFFERENT PERSPECTIVES

JLC STUDENTS LEARNED THE IMPORTANCE OF NETWORKING & LINKEDIN



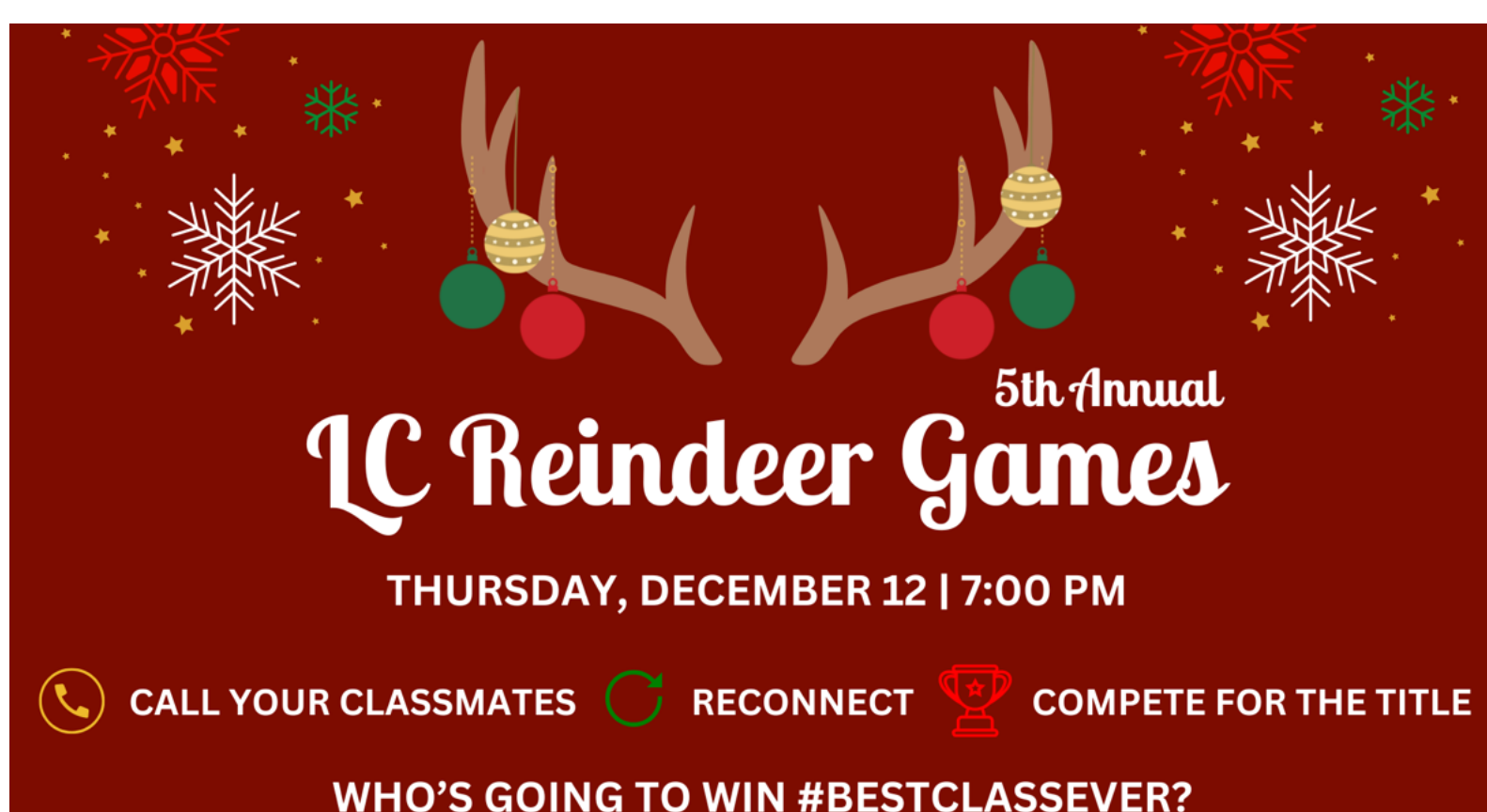

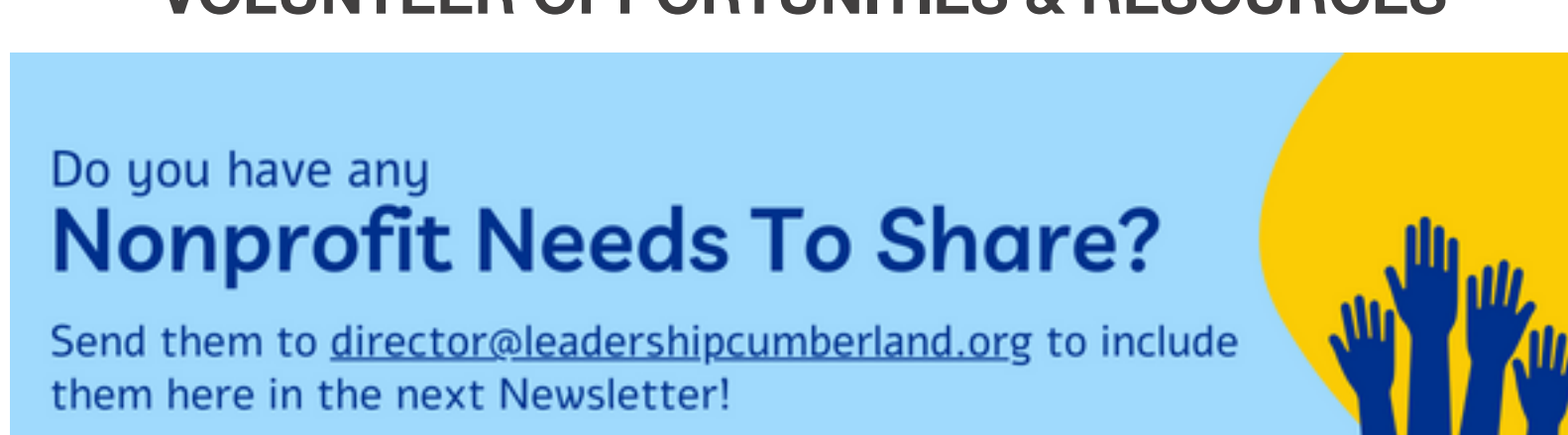
