The Foundation for Enhancing Communities (TFEC) offers a range of competitive grant opportunities to meet area needs. Eligible applicants must have 501 (c) (3) status, utilize a fiscal sponsor with 501 (c) (3) status or demonstrate nonprofit status as a church, school or similar entity. Applicants may apply to multiple grant opportunities, but may not submit more than one grant application to each opportunity. The application may begin at any time during the open application period. TFEC grant making does not fund advertising, capital campaigns, direct lobbying to influence legislation, individuals, religious organizations for the propagation of religious doctrine or retroactive projects.
