CARLISLE AREA HEALTHCARE AUXILIARY (CAHA) 2023 SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM
The Auxiliary has sponsored a Scholarship Program since 1976 by first giving scholarships to young students, "candy strippers", who volunteered at the Carlisle Hospital after school and weekends. The Scholarship Program now includes seniors in high school, employees from various nursing facilities and our volunteers and employees of UPMC Carlisle. The healthcare scholarships have provided financial assistance for future RNs or LPNs, Physicians Assistants, Respiratory Therapists, Physical Therapists, Occupational Therapists and Radiation Therapists.

CAHA is hosting the annual Scholarship Tea on Wednesday, June 21, 2023 at UPMC Carlisle to celebrate the seven student recipients of this year's scholarships. They include five nursing majors, a speech therapist and a radiation therapist. The Auxiliary was able to give \$17,500 among the recipients to include named scholarships in memory of special people to the Auxiliary. CAHA is proud of our many students past and present. Our community benefits greatly as many of these skilled healthcare workers are now employed locally at UPMC Carlisle, at Rehabilitation and Long Term Care facilities and at local medical practices.
